Dr. Thalia Arawi holds a BA in Sociology, an MA in Political and Moral Philosophy, and PhDs in Philosophy and Bioethics. She is the Founding Director of the Salim El-Hoss Bioethics and Professionalism Program (SHBPP) at the American University of Beirut Faculty of Medicine and Medical Center. The SHBPP is the first and only Regional Bioethics and Professionalism Program in the Arab Region and was recently designated as the first WHO Collaborating Center for Ethics in the Arab Region.

Dr. Arawi is recognized as the first Arab specialist in Bioethics. She serves as the Clinical Bioethicist, Clinical Ethics Consultant, and Certified Healthcare Mediator at AUBMC. Notably, she is the first Arab appointed to the board of the International Association of Bioethics and holds memberships in the American Society of Bioethics, the Canadian Society of Bioethics, the Provincial Health Ethics Network, the UK Clinical Ethics Network, and the Lebanese National Advisory Commission of the Ethics in Life Sciences and Healthcare, among others.

Dr. Arawi is a founding member and Advisory Board member of the Bioethics Network on Women's Issues in the Arab Region and was elected as its first Chair. She has been elected as a Senior Fellow at the ge2p2 global foundation, which focuses on the advancement of ethical and scientific rigor in research and evidence generation for governance, policy, and practice in various fields. She is also a Senior Fellow at the ge2p2 Center for Disaster and Humanitarian Ethics.

Additionally, Dr. Arawi is the first Arab consultant at the Center for Conflict Resolution in Healthcare LLC, Memphis, TN, and a member of the WHO COVID-19 Ethics Working Group. She was appointed as the Liaison Officer and Bioethics Focal Point to the Prime Minister. Furthermore, she is a member of the WeCope (World Emergency COVID Pandemic Ethics Committee) and the Bioethics Consultant to the Health Impact Fund (Yale).

Dr. Arawi has participated in numerous national, regional, and international conferences and has several publications on bioethics. Her research interests include clinical ethics, biomedical ethics, philosophy of medicine, humanitarian medicine, ethics and refugees, bioethics in conflict zones, ethics and mental health, and medical education.

Since moral courage requires a steadfast commitment to standing up for what is right, the SHBPP established an annual award to be offered to encourage residents, fellows, and medical students at AUBMC to continue being a role model in moral courage, particularly when it comes to patient centered care. The award is aligned with AUBMC 2020 Vision in that it gives supremacy to patient-centered care and emphasizes the value of doing the right thing even in the most challenging situations. Under the auspices of the Salim El-Hoss Bioethics and Professionalism Program (SHBPP), Ms. Diala Itani, the wife of the late Mr. Abdul Wahhab Itani will grant the award to the candidate who exemplifies qualities of moral courage and shows integrity and consistency of thought and action. Ms. Itani believes that professional moral courage leads the way to value-based decisions. The willingness to question, speak up, and be courageous in a world filled with inequities deserves to be a priority in the work setting Potential recipients include residents, fellows, and medical students (year 3 and 4) at AUBMC. The recipient shall receive \$1000, an award, and a moral courage pin.

### SHBPPs first fundraising Art Exhibition SHE

The Salim El-Hoss Bioethics and Professionalism Program held its first art exhibition "She - " commemorating International Women's Day in the continuous effort to promote and enhance ethics and professionalism, and to champion issues relevant regional issues which include foremost the empowerment of women. The art exhibition took place in the Gold Souk, Beirut Souks between April 4th April 10th, 2018 in the presence of his Excellency the Lebanese Minister of State for Women's Affairs Mr. Jean Oguasabian, Ms. Lina Daghlawi Moukarzel, president of the Council of Arab Women, and the press. The exhibit featured contemporary art works by Mr. Fadi Aloweid on internationally prominent female figures who have had significant and lasting impacts in history through their contributions to the arts, sciences, social, social activism, and humanism. 30% of the proceeds from the sale of the artworks were dedicated to support the SHBPP in its continuous and upcoming initiatives.

#### Commitment to Humane Medicine

On January 30, 2018, SHBPP celebrated AUBMCs commitment to Humane Medicine and the official release of the M=EC2 equation denoting that "Medicine is about Empathy, Caring and Curing".

The event featured a number of guest speakers, a short video marking the birth of Risho and Risha, and a musical performance (entitled Compassio Verague) that was invented specifically for this event and played with an orchestra and accompanying choreographed piece by the IC Middle School Performing Arts Club -Ras Beirut. The dance portrayed a patient struggling with her fear during her clinical encounter with her physician. The aim was to demonstrate the need for humane medical practice and its impact on patient care. The performance was followed by a live testimony of a patient suffering from GBM. The president and the Dean were presented with the AUBMC Humane Medicine flag by the Founding Director of the SHBPP. Prior to the event, LeMSIC volunteers set up interactive booths outside SML and in front of AUBMC entrance. They introduced the concept of Humane Medicine to medical students, residents, physicians, nurses, and AUBMC staff and engaged them in interactive activities about ethics and humanism in medical practice! The Medical Humanism Fund volunteers also held a bake sale on the same day at AUBMC main lobby which included tasty cakes and hot drinks from Café Younes from which proceeds went to support needy patients.

#### THE SHBPP #ETHICSMATTERS

It is widely accepted that the hidden curriculum plays a significant role in nurturing values of ethics and professionalism in both the academic and professional setting. - 1) Developing a code of practice for the media in relation to reporting stories related to medical error, medicine, or any health/public health issues
- 2) Compassionate Use (aka Expanded Access)
- 3) Working on regulations for clinical trials that involve use of medical devices

Through the program, students will be able to work from AUB or home and make use of MOPH guidance and resources (if available). At the end of the internship, a certificate of recognition and appreciation will be presented to the interns on behalf of the MOHP and SHBPP, and most importantly the work accomplished will be considered for implementation at the national level.
