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Add or Remove an Apple device from iCloud

Are you curious about how to remove iCloud from your iPad/iPhone? Do you need to give away or sell your iPad, and you don't want someone else to have access to your iCloud account? Removing your iCloud account doesn't take much time if you do it the right way, and it's definitely something that you should consider doing before you get rid of your iPhone, iPad or iPod.

If you are no longer going to be the owner of your iPhone, you should remove iCloud account. This is for security reasons. If you don't remove iCloud account from your iPhone, your identity could be stolen and people could possibly have access to your purchases. It's better to be on the safe side and remove the account.

As a complete iOS unlocking toolkit, iRemover can easily meet your unlocking demands, no matter whether your iPhone is linked to an unknown Apple ID, you need to remove your Apple ID, or you forget your Apple ID email or password. By using its iCloud Activation Unlocker feature, you can easily bypass iCloud Activation Lock without Apple ID or Apple ID password.

There are some outstanding features you need to know about AnyUnlock – iPhone Password Unlocker:

Bypass iCloud Activation Lock on iPhone iPad iPod touch with a few clicks.

Check iPhone/iPad unlock status when you bought a second-hand one.

Find the linked Apple ID or sign out of the current Apple ID of the iOS device in a simple way.

Crack various iOS screen locks, involving numerical password/PIN/Face ID/Touch ID on your iPhone/iPad.

To bypass the iCloud Activation lock, you should free download the AnyUnlock – iCloud Bypass Tool based on your computer operating system. This application is compatible with both Windows PC and Mac.

Also, if you're having problems getting iCloud to work, it can be helpful to remove your account from your iPhone and then add it again. In this case, deleting the account is just temporary. There are many reasons as to why you would want to delete iCloud from your iPhone. Sometimes, you may simply forget your passwords or are changing their iCloud account emails and want to just delete the old one without any hassle.

Part 1: How to Delete iCloud Account without Password - Using iRemover

This is the easiest way to delete iCloud account without password when your iPhone is activated. Using iRemover is your best choice because it just takes you a few minutes. iRemover is specifically developed to unlock Apple ID iCloud account/lock screen/MDM/Screen Time from iPhone, iPad or iPod touch even when "Find My iPhone" is enabled.

If your device is running on iOS 7 or later (iOS 17 included), the process of deleting iCloud account without password is going to be fairly easy for you.

'Find My iPhone' is a handy application available from iCloud.com, that is used for tracing your iPhone or iPad if it is lost or misplaced.

If your device goes missing, you can put it in 'Lost Mode' immediately. This feature will then display where your device is and allow you to track where it's been. You can immediately lock your device and send it a message with a contact number. Then whoever finds it can call you from the Lock screen without accessi

ng the rest of the information on your device.

To set it up follow the instructions below;

To add a device

Sign in to [iCloud.com](http://icloud.com) or use the 'Find my iPhone' app to see your missing iPhone, iPad, iPod touch or Mac on a map.

Open Settings

Tap on iCloud

If you aren't signed in already, enter your Apple ID and password (your iCloud credentials)

Turn on the toggle for "Find My iPhone"

It's that easy. You will be prompted to turn on Location Services if it is inactive.

Handy Tip; Activation Lock is designed to prevent anyone from using your Apple device. If you ever lose your device, it will start working the moment you turn on "Find My iPhone". From then on your iCloud credentials will be required before anyone can turn this feature off, erase your device or reactivate it.

Deleting a device or remote erase.

Sometimes it's better to be safe than sorry. If you're worried that your device has fallen into the wrong hands, you may want to initiate a remote wipe to delete your personal data and restore your device to its factory settings. Note that Find My iPhone will continue to display your customised message even after the device has been erased. And if you do retrieve your device, you can restore it from your iCloud backup.

Removing a device is easy when you delink the device. This process is as simple as turning off the switch from Settings → iCloud.

But if you do want to completely remove the device from your iCloud account, follow the steps below:

Open a browser and go to <http://icloud.com>

Sign in to your account

Click on "Find My iPhone"

Click on All Devices and then select the device you want to remove

Click on "Remove from Account"

This will remove the device from your account.
